rnt_q1. An international treaty banning the development, production, deployment and use of nuclear weapons was adopted in 2017 by 122 countries at the United Nations. The treaty puts nuclear weapons in the same category as other weapons of mass destruction (which have been banned previously by international treaty). So far, 70 countries have signed this treaty (i.e., they have agreed to comply with its terms) and of them, 26 have ratified it (i.e., they have passed legislation in their countries to ensure that they comply with its terms).
